Post setting up this academy in 2017, we have focussed on enhancing the capacity of the program over last 5 years, to about 70 athletes presently with an equal gender ratio , who have been selected in our recently conducted national level trials and have participated from various parts of the country on the basis of talent and future potential, right from local school levels to national levels of competency .

Even though we faced tough challenges in the covid years and activities at the academy had slowed down immensely due to external factors, we managed to sustain the programs with goodwill and support of our well wishers and donors.

I, thereby present this Annual Report of the organisation which would be a consolidated coverage of last 5 years (2017 to 2023 ) and feature highlights of all aspects of our programs.
